TC3 TIPPED FOR MACAU FINALE

The new TC3 International touring car series looks set to replace the World Touring Car Championship in Macau in 2015.

A provisional calendar includes Formula 1 support slots in Malaysia, China and Singapore, and an unassigned November date.

AUTOSPORT understands that this will be Macau, with the WTCC set to end its 10-year run at the venue (pictured) this month.

Further prestige slots for TC3, an initiative of former WTCC boss Marcello Lotti, include Monza, Sochi and ex-F1 venue Buenos Aires.
