

# New racers debut at Paris show

IT wasn't just road cars taking to the stage at last week's Paris Motor show – several brands also pulled the wraps off the latest racing versions of their big-selling models, including Audi, Porsche, Toyota and Hyundai.

Audi's hot new RS3 saloon (Page 13) was joined by a touring-car version that'll be eligible to compete in series around the world, more of next year's new WRC machinery was revealed and Porsche unveiled the latest iteration of its hugely popular 911 GT3 Cup one-make racer.

AUDI'S Customer Racing division is best known for producing the big-selling R8 GT3 for sportscar racing. It's built to TCR rules (currently used by 18 touring-car championships worldwide), makes 330bhp and will be available for purchase by privateer teams for the start of the 2017 season.
